

Brooks and Warren met as teenagers in Nashville and remained friends for 65 years, teaching together at Louisiana State University and later Yale. Along the way, they collaborated on the enormously influential textbooks Understanding Poetry (1938) and Understanding Fiction (1943), which helped establish the New Criticism as the primary method of interpreting literary texts in this country. Grimshaw (regents professor. Texas A&M Univ.) has gathered 372 letters that detail their collaboration on these and other books.
